



2008 Code of Conduct

Snap-on Stars of Karting, and its Officials, acting as the ultimate authority over its organization, name-sake (and likeness), and its events, will utilize the following Code of Conduct Regulation to govern the actions and behaviors of all persons doing business with and/or associating with the Snap-on Stars of Karting and its Events. The Code of Conduct will guide the decisions of the Snap-on Stars of Karting, and its Officials in a way that contributes to the well being of its operation, partners and sponsors, Events and Venues, and its membership, (to include all Snap-on Stars of Karting Licensed Drivers and all persons associated with them; whether present at Events or not).

The Snap-on Stars of Karting is proud of its leadership and reputation as a world class racing and entertainment organization, which is committed to the highest ethical standards. Persons associated with and/or in attendance at an Event will be held accountable for their actions and the actions of persons associated with them, (to include but are not limited to Officials, Drivers, Pit Pass Holders, Spectators at Large, Media), and are expected to respect the Snap-on Stars of Karting and its host venues.

Any acts of disrespect towards the Snap-on Stars of Karting, it's Venues or properties, Sponsors, Partners, Shareholders, License Holders, or Membership that would deface their image, either publicly or privately will results in the responsible party(s) being excluded from association with the Snap-on Stars of Karting indefinitely. It will be the sole judgment of the Snap-on Stars of Karting to determine whether an act of disrespect warrants exclusion, and its decision is final.

By engaging in and/or participating with Snap-on Stars of Karting business and/or Events, all persons will conduct themselves in accordance with this code, and understand and accept the core values the code represents.
